

## MicroStrategy Certified Engineer (MCE) Renewal Exam

### Overview:

This exam tests the candidate's knowledge on the latest version of the MicroStrategy platform. The exam covers topics discussed in the "What's New for MicroStrategy 9 & 9.0.1" instructor-led course series. It also includes concepts related to MicroStrategy products that are taught in the instructor-led courses listed on the right. Students can prepare for the exam by either attending the instructor-led courses or reviewing the equivalent online courses. MCE Renewal candidates who pass the MCE Renewal Exam will retain their MCE Certification status for the MicroStrategy 9.0.1 version (also called MicroStrategy 9, Release 2). If the candidate fails the MCE Renewal Exam, they will have one chance to retake the exam. If the candidate fails the retake exam, they will be required to obtain MCE status through the currently defined requirements of the comprehensive MCE Program, as if for the first time.

### Number of Days:

- 1 day (administered on a MicroStrategy Testing Day)

### Who Should Attend:

- Any MicroStrategy Certified Engineer (MCE) with a MicroStrategy 9 or previous certification status who wants to renew his/her MCE status

### Testing Day Language Policy:

Non-native English speaking students wishing to use a *language dictionary* (English to English dictionaries excluded) during MicroStrategy Certification exams must arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of the Testing Day. An instructor will examine the dictionary and only those language dictionaries without written notes within the pages will be allowed. Sharing language dictionaries is also strictly prohibited.

- The exam covers general MicroStrategy concepts from the following core courses as well:
  - MicroStrategy Desktop: Reporting Essentials
  - MicroStrategy Architect: Project Design Essentials
  - MicroStrategy Report Services: Document Essentials
  - MicroStrategy Report Services: Dynamic Dashboards
  - MicroStrategy Desktop: Advanced Reporting
  - MicroStrategy Administration (v9) OR MicroStrategy Administration: Configuration and Security (v901) and MicroStrategy Administration: Application Management and Tuning (v901)
  
- MCE certification status from a previous version (see "Who Should Attend")

### Format:

- Online or written exam (approx. 3 hours), depending on the location of the Testing Day

### Certification Criteria:

- 75% to pass to the original attempt, 75% to pass the retake attempt
