

What's New in MicroStrategy 9 for Project Architects

Overview:

This 1-day course covers the new MicroStrategy Architect features available to project architects in MicroStrategy 9. Students will learn how to use the Architect graphical interface to design MicroStrategy projects within a consolidated interface. They will also learn how to use MicroStrategy MultiSource Option to configure projects to access heterogeneous data sources. Finally, students will briefly review a variety of new features and enhancements in MicroStrategy Architect. Students will get hands-on practice through exercises.
