

MicroStrategy Certified Engineer (MCE) Renewal Exam

Overview:

This exam tests the candidate's knowledge on the latest version of the MicroStrategy platform. The exam covers topics discussed in the "What's New" on-line course series. It also includes subjects that are taught in the instructor-led courses that correspond to the latest MicroStrategy platform versions. MCE Renewal candidates who pass the MCE Renewal Exam will retain their MCE Certification status for another 12 months. If the candidate fails the MCE Renewal Exam, they will have one chance to retake the exam. If the candidate fails the retake exam, they will be required to obtain MCE status through the currently defined requirements of the comprehensive MCE Program, as if for the first time.

Cost:

- US\$200 per exam

Number of Days:

- 1 day (administered on a MicroStrategy Testing Day)

Who Should Attend:

- Any MicroStrategy Certified Engineer (MCE) with an expired certification status (that is more than 12 months old) who wants to renew his/her MCE status

Testing Day Language Policy:

Non-native English speaking students wishing to use a *language dictionary* (English to English dictionaries excluded) during MicroStrategy Certification exams must arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of the Testing Day. An instructor will examine the dictionary and only those language dictionaries without written notes within the pages will be allowed. Sharing language dictionaries is also strictly prohibited.

- For candidates who are familiar with the MicroStrategy platform since the 7.0 release, the following courses are recommended:

 - MicroStrategy Narrowcasting Essentials
- For candidates who have only worked on version 6.x or previous, the following courses are recommended:
 - MicroStrategy Desktop: Reporting Essentials
 - MicroStrategy Architect: Project Design
 - MicroStrategy Report Services: Document Essentials
 - MicroStrategy Desktop: Advanced Reporting 100
 - MicroStrategy Intelligence Server Administration
 - MicroStrategy Narrowcasting Essentials

Topics:

- Written exam (approx. 3 hours)
- Exam graded by the instructor

Certification Criteria:

- 75% to pass, 85% to pass the retake.
