

MicroStrategy Project Designer Exam

Overview:

This exam is designed to certify students on the skills and knowledge needed to create a MicroStrategy project from scratch. Students will be tested on concepts covered in the MicroStrategy Desktop: Reporting Essentials and MicroStrategy Architect: Project Design courses through an exam. An instructor will proctor and grade the exam on site. Students who pass the exam attain MicroStrategy Certified Project Designer status and receive a certificate.

Cost:

- US\$200 per exam

- 1 day (administered on a MicroStrategy Testing Day)

Certification Criteria:

- 75% to pass, 85% to pass a retake

Testing Day Language Policy:

Non-native English speaking students wishing to use a *language dictionary* (English to English dictionaries excluded) during MicroStrategy Certification exams must arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of the Testing Day. An instructor will examine the dictionary and only those language dictionaries without written notes within the pages will be allowed. Sharing language dictionaries is also strictly prohibited.
