

MicroStrategy Report Services: Dynamic Dashboards 100

Overview:

This one-day course explores the features and functionality of Report Services Dynamic Enterprise Dashboards™ (available as of MicroStrategy 8.1). The course begins by introducing students to general dashboarding methodology and best practices. Students then learn about the individual features that make it possible to create fully interactive dashboards. Topics include features such as panel stacks, selector controls, MicroStrategy's out-of-the-box Flash widgets, and several graph formatting options. The course covers standard DHTML functionality as well as Flash functionality. Students will get hands-on practice throughout the course through a series of exercises.
