- Network with attendees and book 1:1 meetings (attendees with visible profile only)
- Download available session material or material made available in any potential exhibit
- Food and beverage may be provided at certain MicroWorld events. If provided, participants assume any and all risks associated with the consumption of the food and beverage prepared and/or served at such events. To the extent alcohol is made available at certain events, MicroStrategy is not liable for any damages incurred directly or indirectly due to an attendee's consumption of alcohol.

Social Media

All of the social conversation and imagery shared during the MicroWorld events will be captured, moderated, shared with attendees, and possibly rebroadcast to MicroStrategy followers. Should you share socially about any MicroWorld event and your experiences at such event you hereby irrevocably grant MicroStrategy permission to include your posts/imagery about the event both onsite as well as online. This includes all photos taken and shared on social media relating to the MicroWorld event.

Release of Contact Information to Third Parties

Privacy Information

The data collected through the registration process for any of the MicroWorld events is stored and processed in the United States. However, we have put in place appropriate technological and organizational measures to ensure that your data is kept strictly confidential and will only use or process your personal data to the extent allowed by the applicable data protection laws governing your personal data including, without limitation, the EU's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We will only use your personal data to provide you access to the events (virtual and in person) for which you register for, as well as to communicate with you about MicroWorld sessions in general. Also, by consenting to these Terms, you are agreeing that your personal data may be shared with our sponsoring partners with whom you have interacted with during the event, including registering for and attending partner sessions, visiting sponsored booths, etc. In addition, and only if you have given your consent during the registration process to receive marketing material from MicroStrategy, we will use it for the purpose of distribution of publications, newsletters, invitations or other marketing information, or marketing or sales activities.

The virtual event platform includes a feature that allows audio, video, and textual information exchanged or viewed during the virtual online sessions to be recorded.
